Guidelines and Instructions for applying online for Admission Session 2023-2025

- Candidates will require a scanned copy of a recent passport size photograph and a scanned copy of his signature
- Candidates will require to upload scanned copies of all their testimonials
- Candidates should enter a valid mobile number and an e-mail id, required for future correspondence
- Visit college website www.gtchooghly.ac.in to find admission portal and fill in the form (Link of the same is also provided in the brochure)
- After filling up the form, click "Save and Continue" to verify your filled in form and then submit (College Authority will not be responsible for any false information provided by the candidate)
- Take a printout of the filled in application for future reference. It will be required during counseling and admission. Do not send the hardcopy of the filled in Form now.

<u>Eligibility Criteria</u>

Candidates (both Fresh and Deputed) with at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor's Degree (50% in aggregate combing Honours and Elective subjects) and/or in the Master's Degree in Humanities/Social Science/Science or Bachelors in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the programme. Relaxation of 5% in favour of SC/ST/PWD.

(As per NCTE Regulation, 2014 and following the rules of Baba Saheb Ambedkar Education University (BSAEU) and Department of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal)

Documents required at the Time of Counselling and Spot Admission

- All testimonials in original and 2 sets of self-attested photocopies (i.e., all marksheets, certificates, age proof, Caste certificate, PwD Certificate, EWS certificate, residential proof, Aadhar card)
- Candidates with CGPA method of mark sheet must ensure CGPA to percentage conversion formula of the respective university.
- ✤ Self-attested photocopy of filled in application form
- Two passport size photographs
- Printout of payment slip (after being selected)

 - Original M.C. Resolution duly counter signed by D.I. /A.D.I.
 - Original Teaching experience certificate from class VI onwards issued by H.M./TIC/Principal
 - Original and photocopies of service appointment letter

 - Govt. Order (For Govt. Deputed Candidate)
 - Anti-ragging Form duly filled in (format to be downloaded from website <u>http://www.gtchooghly.ac.in</u>). For students who have been selected, it is required to submit separate anti-ragging forms for both college and hostel if they choose to stay in the hostel. During the admission process, students must submit a plain declaration on a blank sheet of paper, and later on, they will need to submit an affidavit. Admission Procedure

Important Points to be noted before Counseling

- Mere inclusion of name in the list for counseling does not guarantee one's final admission to the course. Data provided in the online application should be corroborated with the original documents in course of physical verification.
- As and when the seat(s) of any subject will be filled, immediately the counseling and admission for that subject will be declared closed.
- Listed candidate who will remain absent in the particular day and time of counseling will not be considered for next counseling process whatsoever his merit position be. Automatically next candidate as per score will be considered in the similar manner.
- Students who will be admitted in either the 1st or 2nd Counselling are required to notify the college of their admission cancellation through email (with proper reason) by September 30th, 2023. Only then the college will consider 60% refund of their admission fee and hostel fee (if paid). No requests for cancellation and refund will be entertained after the deadline of September 30th, 2023.

If no Deputed candidate is found eligible then the seats reserved for deputed will be converted into fresher seat (After getting permission from the university, BSAEU)

SC/ST candidates residing outside of West Bengal will be treated as general candidate.

Differently Abled candidates having less than 40% disability will be treated as a general candidate.

EWS – Candidates having EWS certificate issued by the competent authority (DM/ADM/SDO/DWO) will come under the reservation policy declared by the state govt. (Refer to Govt. of West Bengal Office Memorandum – 325 - PAR (AR)/3P-1/2019 and Kolkata Gazette no. 339-Edn (CS)/OM-74L/2003 of 26^{th} May, 2023) in place of conversion of seats meant for reserved category as and when applicable.

N.B. The above subject wise reservation shown in the seat matrix may be changed due to non-availability of the said categories. In such circumstances the number of reservations will be maintained distributing seats, stream/ group wise (Language, Social Science, Science, Mathematics, Music).

- It is necessary to present the admission fee and all required documents on the day and time of admission. Failure to do so may result in denial of admission. Additionally, if any of the documents are found to be invalid, the admission may be cancelled at any time.
- After successful completion of the admission process classes will commence from 3rd October, 2023
- Hostel fees including lodging, electricity etc. Rs. 6000 (for 2 years) will have to be deposited on or before admission into hostel in consultation with hostel superintendent. Those who live beyond 50 kms from college should occupy the hostel and ensure regular attendance in college.
