







- Abstract and Full-length Paper Font Size of text is 12.
- The Abstract should not exceed 300 words (Including Five Keywords) and the Full-length Paper should not exceed 6000 words.
- Full-length Paper citation must be done in APA style.
- Abstract and Full-length Paper must be sent after proof checking.
- Liability for spelling mistakes or plagiarism rests entirely with the paper presenters. The organizer will not take any responsibility in this regard.
- After the scrutiny of 'Abstract', the review committee will send an email or contact to the accepted candidates and asked to send the 'Full-length Paper'.

- Participants who register for the Seminar with an Abstract will be given the opportunity to present their paper.
- Only full-length research papers will be published based on the selection of the peer review committee.
- The selected papers will be published in an edited ISSN journal/book.
